The Voter Activation Network is a **set of tools** for interacting with the **voter data** to contact voters

You can think of VAN in two types of buckets...

- The Voter Activation Network, or VAN, is a suite of tools for managing voter databases, analytics, and outreach work.
- VAN is built on the Michigan Voter File, which contains records for all registered voters in Michigan.
- The Voter File is updated monthly from the Secretary of State, so you will always have an up-to-date database of all the registered voters in your district.



- We use several other types of data to enhance the raw voter file to create a comprehensive voter outreach and analytics toolset for campaigns and local parties:
 - Consumer data
 - Census information
 - Analytics
 - Voter contact data



- With VAN, you'll benefit from over a decade of field work in Michigan:
 - The voter file improves constantly as users remove voters who have moved and clean up phone numbers.
 - Michigan field responses are used to train models and improve voter contact targets
 - Enter your data!!!




Field Operation

- Cut turf and load them into MiniVAN for easy door-to-door canvassing
- Create targeted mailing lists formatted for mail merge and mailing vendors





Data and analysis

- Store your own data across cycles for keeping track of supporters and volunteers
- Target the voters you're looking for with models created in-house and updated daily
- Data analysis tools
 - Reports
 - Detailed Canvass results
 - Counts and Crosstabs



VAN for Candidates

- VAN fees are scaled based on the population of each candidate's district to make
 VAN accessible to any type of campaign*
- Candidates who are elected can retain access to their VAN committee for constituency work during their term until their next election year
- VAN access can be renewed by candidates running for re-election. Any work done in
 VAN can be accessed and used across multiple cycles



VAN for Candidates

- New (and renewed) candidate VAN committees include:
 - A set of survey questions to track candidate support, volunteers, and yard sign requests
 - Access to cross-committee survey questions and constituency activist codes used by local Parties and Clubs
 - A basic starter script



VAN for Local Parties, Clubs, and Caucuses

- VAN can be provided free of charge to MDP chartered Parties, Clubs, and Caucuses
- VAN is an important tool for party building
- Track your supporters, volunteers, donors, and activists over multiple cycles
- Help local candidates
- Schedule events and track attendance
 - Mobilize integration



Collaborate!

- VAN makes it easy to collaborate with local groups and other candidates with VAN access
- Share survey questions and activist codes with other VAN committees
 - This allows you to share responses you've collected that could be helpful to an allied campaign
 - Allows those groups to add your survey questions to voter contact scripts so they can also collect IDs for your campaign


